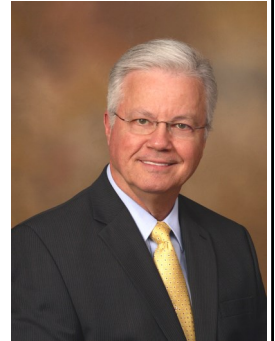




THE VISION

Please pray for a smooth and blessed Promotion Day!

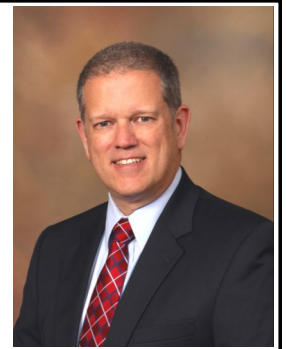
