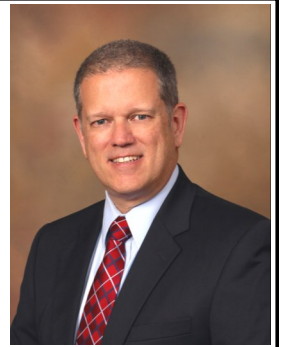


SHOW ME YOUR WAYS
