## Genesis 7:1 – 8:14

What Happened	Month & Day	Year of Noah's Life	Reference
God told Noah, his family, and the animals to enter the Ark; Rain to begin in 7 days	2 <sup>nd</sup> month, 10 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 7:1-9
Flood began	2 <sup>nd</sup> month, 17 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 7:10-11
40 days of rain	2 <sup>nd</sup> month, 17 <sup>th</sup> day thru 3 <sup>rd</sup> month, 26 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen 7:12
Flood waters remained a total of 150 days (this includes the 40 days of rain)	2 <sup>nd</sup> month, 17 <sup>th</sup> day thru 7 <sup>th</sup> month, 17 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 7:24 – 8:4
Tops of mountains became visible	10 <sup>th</sup> month, 1 <sup>st</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 8:5
Noah opened window of the Ark and released a raven and dove; The dove returned	11 <sup>th</sup> month, 10 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 8:6-9
Noah released dove again; It returned with olive leaf	11 <sup>th</sup> month, 17 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 8:10-11
Noah released dove again; It did not return	11 <sup>th</sup> month, 24 <sup>th</sup> day	600 <sup>th</sup>	Gen. 8:12
Waters were dried up; Noah saw dry land	1 <sup>st</sup> month, 1 <sup>st</sup> day	601 <sup>st</sup>	Gen. 8:13
The earth was dry; God told Noah, his family, and the animals to leave the Ark	2 <sup>nd</sup> month, 27 <sup>th</sup> day	601 <sup>st</sup>	Gen. 8:14
