Who Are You?

That may sound like a strange question. You know who you are. You know your name, your age, and your occupation. You know your marital status, your address, and your phone number. You know who you are, right?

The opening verses of the book of Ephesians tells us as believers **who we are in Jesus Christ**. It describes the things God has done for us in salvation. I encourage you to read Ephesians 1:1-14. In those verses you will discover that if you belong to Jesus, you are:

1. **Blessed** by God the Father (v. 3)
2. **Chosen** by the Lord before the foundation of the world (v. 4)
3. **Adopted** as a child of God by Jesus Christ (v. 5)
4. **Accepted** by God (v. 6)
5. **Redeemed** through the blood of Jesus (v. 7a)
6. **Forgiven** of your sins by His grace (v. 7b)
7. **Told** His will (v. 9)
8. **Promised an inheritance** in the future (v. 11)
9. **Given Trust** in the Bible (v. 13a)
10. **Enabled to Believe** in the Gospel (v. 13b)
11. **Sealed** by the Holy Spirit (v. 13c)
12. **Given the Holy Spirit** as the earnest of your inheritance (v. 14)

Wow! That should brighten your day, regardless of your difficulties. Praise God for His grace!

Sunday School

Our Sunday School study of the Gospel of Matthew is entering the “fourth quarter.” We began Matthew back in September. Matthew has 28 chapters, and last Sunday we studied chapter 21, so we are three-quarters of the way through the book.

The final seven chapters of Matthew describe many important events in the life of our Lord. The attacks by the Jewish religious leaders become more and more intense, and Jesus gives us a glimpse into the end times. We will learn about the Last Supper and Jesus’ betrayal, arrest, and crucifixion. The Gospel of Matthew ends with Jesus’ resurrection and commission to His followers. I hope you’ll plan to be present for Sunday School each of the next seven weeks as we study the final chapters of Matthew.


