Romans 8 – Session 1

Verse 1:

- What does **condemnation** mean? judgment, verdict, penalty
- Who is free from condemnation? those in Christ = those who are saved

Verse 2:

- What has Jesus done for us? made us free from the law of sin and death
- What's the connection between sin and death? (Rom. 6:23) sin leads to death

Verse 3:

- Why couldn't the Law (human effort) save us? because it was dependent on our weak human flesh
- How did Jesus condemn sin in the flesh? He lived a sinless life in human flesh and then died to pay for our sin with His blood

Verse 4:

- What is fulfilled in us? the righteous requirements of the Law
- "After the flesh" = lost; "after the Spirit" = saved

Verse 5:

- What controls lost people? their flesh
- What controls saved people? the Holy Spirit

Verse 6:

- What does **carnal** mean? fleshly, unsaved
- Lost, carnal mind → death
- Saved, spiritual mind → life and peace

Verse 7:

- What does **enmity** mean? actively opposed, hostile
- Describe the lost person: hostile to God, disobedient to God

Verse 8:

- Who **cannot** please God? (Heb. 11:6) lost people

Verse 9:

- How do you know you're saved? Holy Spirit lives within
